Seeking expressions of interest in publishing

To date my research results have been posted on the ERIC web site, available free but subject to copyright. One paper gives notice that some forthcoming publications will incur a charge. This is a request for expressions of interest from large publishing houses to publish selected material.

Material ready for publication

The politics of science: controlling the environmental agenda Completed in 2006

Basically an exposé of the conduct of science, as it should be done and how it is done (195pp, 104K words). No names given. Largely based on environmental research in Australia but includes material on the USSR. It applies everywhere.

For the record: against all odds Completed in 2011

My memoirs up until around now (233pp, 132.7K words). 'The religious bit' is short at 13pp, 17.5K words in only addressing its impact on me.

Ascenting science Completed 2011

A collection of almost 200 clip art drawings addressing aspects of science, currently in 55 A4 pages (2K words). The initial theme is the rise and fall of science where captions are informative (30 pages). The second theme is whimsical. Along with the poetry the poems constituted occupational therapy essential at times in coping with my circumstances.

Whimsicals - motley collection of therapeutic poems Completed 2011

Currently 19 poems addressing a diversity of topics but mainly addressing politics, climate change, and the descent of mankind (48 pp, 12.6K words). The material is more revealing than when presented as a manuscript. Illustrated using clip art.

Given my mindset the constructs reflect what suites me rather than any formal requirement. The constructs vary considerably.

Report: Restructuring CSIRO Completed 2011

Examines the developmental history and potential future for CSIRO (34pp, 15K words). Reasons for the existence of CSIRO are addressed and alternatives examined. Requirements for restructuring CSIRO to achieve effective scientific research are given.

While focused on CSIRO the considerations address research generally and have general applicability.

Material that exists but may require editing

The size of the diaries is unknown. Each month is around 30 pp / 17K words.

First diary

Essentially a daily record of the first phase of contact with Energetic life forms. Surreal is an understatement. Covers around 12 months.

The daily record commonly addresses several themes, sometimes 4 or more. The surreal section relates to The Game conducted by Electros. The material may require separation, as with excluding results for observations on the perfield.

Second diary

Mainly daily records for around 18 months documenting the attacks of Electros on me and my attempts at developing devices to eradicate them. Tedious is my reaction but it contains important information.

Anticipated future material

Electros

An analysis of the material in the diaries, particularly 1. This depends on my being able to address the material, something I found emotionally difficult when writing my memoirs.

The analysis is needed as I was completely naive in relation to energetic life forms when compiling the first diary. Some interpretations I now know to be incorrect, and only now do some things make sense. However, it is most unlikely that I will ever be able to explain all despite having lived through it.

Climate Change Science

A book on the conduct and use of science in addressing climate change is an obvious sequel to the Politics of Science. There is already ample material and it keeps being produced.
